Code of Conduct

Player, Coach, Parent, Spectator, Official are required to demonstrate good soccer etiquette and to behave in a responsible and respectful manner at all times. All players, coaches, parents, spectators and officials must abide by and uphold the Code of Conduct as stated below.

Players, coaches, parents, spectators and officials conduct yourself in a manner which:

1. Demonstrates respect to other player, coach, parent, spectators, officials.
2. Demonstrates and encourages good sportsmanship on and off the field
3. Focuses on fun, participation and encourage a recreational attitude
4. Promotes fair play; involve all team members' playing time in game
5. Prioritizes safety and welfare of all participants

Prohibited:

1. Profanity towards a player, coach, parent, spectator or official at any time
2. Criticism towards player, coach, parent, spectator or official at any time
3. Drug, alcohol and tobacco on property before, during or after game
4. Unnecessary physical touch to a player, coach, parent, spectator, official
5. Physical abuse, threat of physical abuse and verbal abuse
6. Abuse of soccer fields, equipment, adjacent grounds, parking lot, concession stand(s) and pavilion(s)

The failure to abide by the rules of the Londonderry Youth Soccer Association Code of Conduct will result in disciplinary action up to and including suspension and/or loss of membership in LYSA.
